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2.9.1 **PURPOSE:** To establish minimum qualifications to participate in the promotional examination for the rank of Captain and Engineer within the El Dorado County Fire Protection District.

2.9.2 **POLICY:** The El Dorado County Fire Protection District requires the following minimum requirements be met in order to be considered eligible to participate in the Captains promotional process or the Engineers promotional process.

**2.9.3 CAPTAIN MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:**

2.9.3.1 A minimum of five (5) years of full-time firefighting experience, three (3) of which must be with the El Dorado County Fire Protection District.

2.9.3.2 CSFM Firefighter 1 Certification

2.9.3.3 CSFM Firefighter 2 Certification

2.9.3.4 CSFM Driver/Operator 1A Certification

2.9.3.5 CSFM Driver/Operator 1B Certifications

2.9.3.6 Valid California Class B Drivers License or Class B license with a Firefighter Restriction

2.9.3.7 Valid EMT -1 Certification

2.9.3.8 Valid CPR Certification

2.9.3.9 Valid AED Certification

2.9.3.10 CFSTES Fire Officer Certification or an Associates Degree in Fire Technology/Science from an accredited college or university or an Associates Degree with a Fire Technology/Science Certificate from an accredited college or university

2.9.3.11 Full time experience is defined as; your primary employment with a minimum of 40 hours per week as a firefighter.

#### **2.9.4 ENGINEER MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:**

- 2.9.4.1 Level II Driver/Operator certified
- 2.9.4.2 Valid California Class "B" drivers license, Commercial drivers license required
- 2.9.4.3 CSFM Firefighter 1 Certification
- 2.9.4.4 CSFM Firefighter 2 Certification
- 2.9.4.5 CSFM Driver/Operator 1A Certification
- 2.9.4.6 CSFM Driver/Operator 1B Certification
- 2.9.4.7 CSFM Rescue System I Certification
- 2.9.4.8 Valid EMT-1 Certification
- 2.9.4.9 Valid CPR Certification
- 2.9.4.10 Valid AED Certification
- 2.9.4.11 Successful Completion of Practical examination
- 2.9.4.12 Successful Completion of Written examination
- 2.9.4.13 Must comply with any additional Local, State, Federal, or OES requirements for operating Fire Apparatus.
