AND EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

3.15.1 **PURPOSE:** To establish a policy and procedure to meet the needs of personnel in areas of incident stress debriefing and managing challenges we are faced with on a daily basis.

3.15.2 **PROCEDURE:** Critical Stress Incident Debriefing
Any Fire District Officer may initiate the process for personnel to be debriefed in situations such as, but not limited to, major fires, mass casualty incidents, incidents involving family members, incidents involving other fire personnel, etc.

All requests for debriefing shall be approved by a Chief Officer or designee.
