## STANDARD OPERATING GUIDELINE

ARTICLE 10: EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE EFFECTIVE DATE: 01-01-1995

SECTION 4: MINIMUM APPARATUS INVENTORY REVISED: 04-12-2006

10.4.1 **PURPOSE:** To establish a minimum equipment inventory for all 24 hour staffed Type 1 Engines. This applies to the following: E-17. E-21, E-23, E-25, E-28, E-72 and E-74.

- 10.4.2 **PROCEDURE:** This inventory is to be checked during the monthly check and upon return from any incident where there is question as to the completeness of that engine's inventory.
- 10.4.3 Any items of equipment damaged during an incident should either be repaired by the duty crew and notification made via "Repair Form," for repair or replacement of equipment.
- 10.4.4 Due to varying geographic areas serviced by the Fire District it is understood that some engines may require an increased inventory. This will require approval from the Fire Chief. Any additions to engine inventory will be noted in the vehicle logbook on a separate sheet to be checked any time the engine inventory is checked.
- 10.4.5 It is not the intent of this policy to restrict or limit the equipment carried on first out Type 1 Engines, but to set a Fire District minimum standard.
