



Joint Powers Authority (JPA)

- **Diamond Springs Fire** continues to be unable to staff **Medic 49**, which shut down on **July 1st**.
 - **Medic 28** has been temporarily relocated to **Station 48** to provide a second core unit.
 - The JPA is actively monitoring call volumes, locations, and system impacts for any further necessary adjustments.
 - Diamond Springs Fire remains under **Force Majeure** and has not made a final decision on the future status of Medic 49.
 - The **JPA Board and EMS Operations Committee (EMSOC)** are reviewing call volumes weekly to identify opportunities for system adjustments.
 - The **JPA Ad-Hoc Medic Unit Staffing Committee** continues progressing on development of a **single-role and/or hybrid staffing model** in preparation for potential system changes.

- Engine 328 was deployed as part of a strike team to the **Electra Fire in Amador County**. All crews have safely returned with no reported issues.
