JLMC (Joint Labor Management Committee)

- The committee is progressing toward a final business plan to present to the Board.
- During the week of **November 2**, JLMC members met with crews on all 3 shifts to discuss the framework and gather input. 
- The plan for a business model change is shaping up — currently finalizing key details and compiling presentation and financial materials. 

CARES Act Funds

- Chief Williams and FF Duncan are working through purchasing and tracking processes; monthly reports are being submitted as required. 
- The JPA also received CARES Act funds for equipment; residual funds may be allocated toward COVID-19-related costs.
- ECF has submitted for **overtime reimbursements** (~\$27k) related to medic unit exposures.

Personnel Updates

- **Firefighter Tyler Ott** has completed his 12-month probation. 
 - Two new Firefighter/Paramedics have started:
 - Jason Vogeli
 - Cole Roth(Both are currently assigned to **Station 28**.)
 - Three FFs are scheduled to attend the **Sacramento City Fire Academy** on **January 4**, with **Captain Adams** attending as a **Drill Instructor**.

- Captain Stirling and Chief met with Deputy Director Jorgenson to review the fleet and remount history. 🚚
 - The **transition of JPA leadership** is complete with Directors Veerkamp and Jorgenson in place.
 - The County is exploring the expansion of **CSA-7** roles to support vegetation management.
 - The County Fire Chiefs met with the CAO and Deputy CAO for a preliminary review.
 - Chiefs and JPA will request additional information as the plan develops. 🌿
