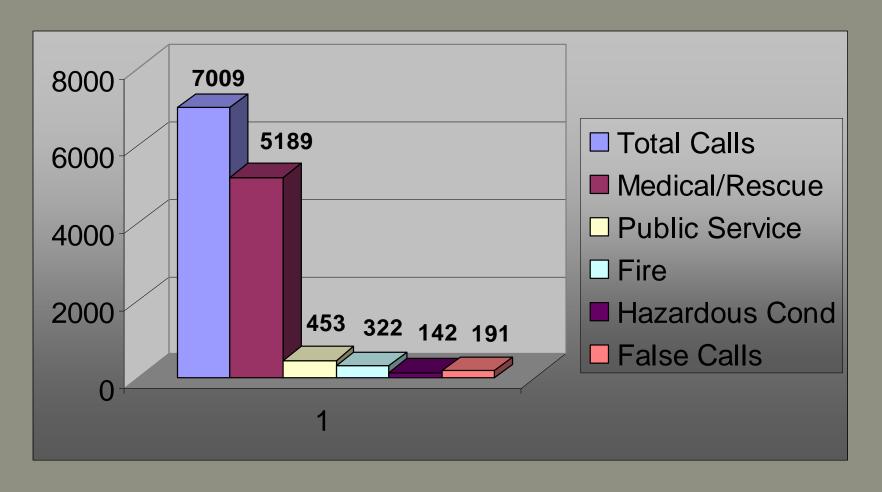

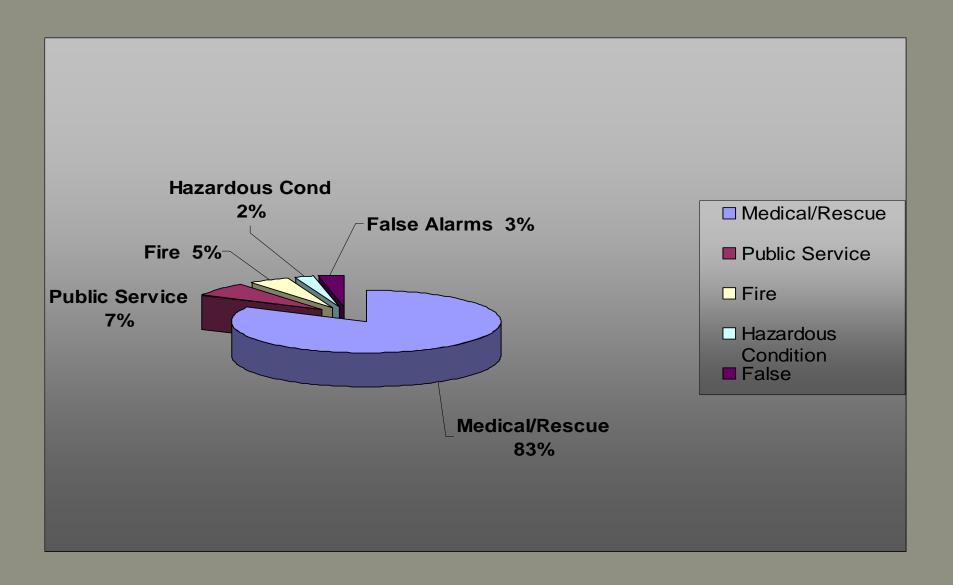




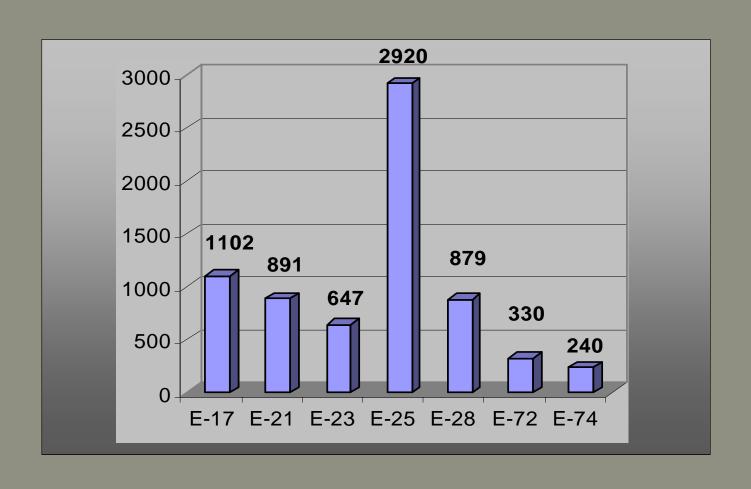
Response Summary



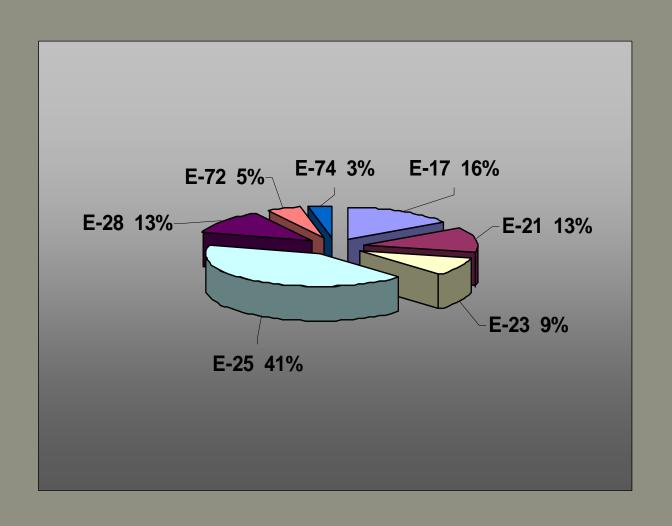
Percentage of Incidents



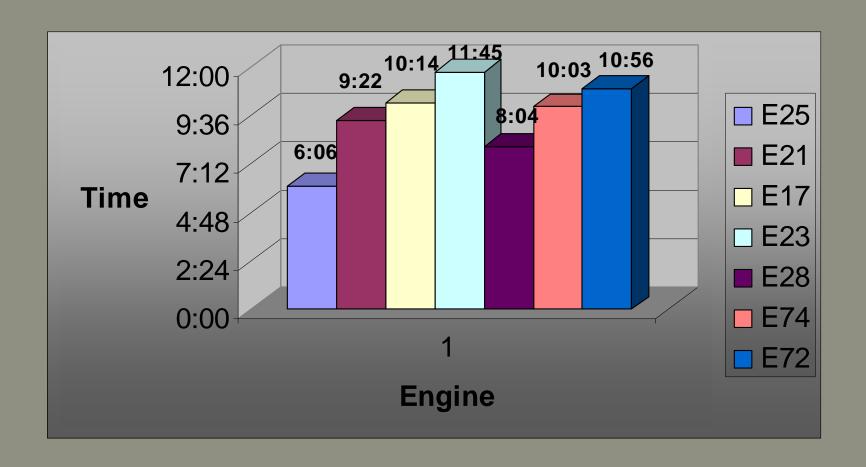
Response by Engine

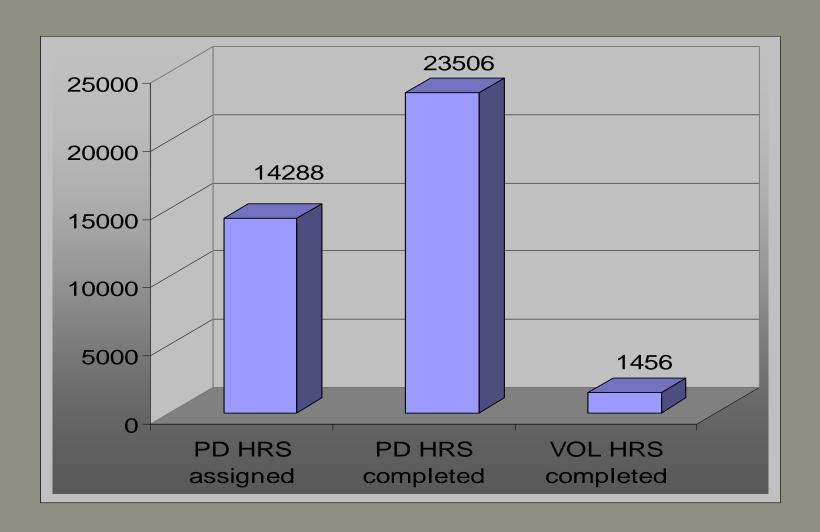

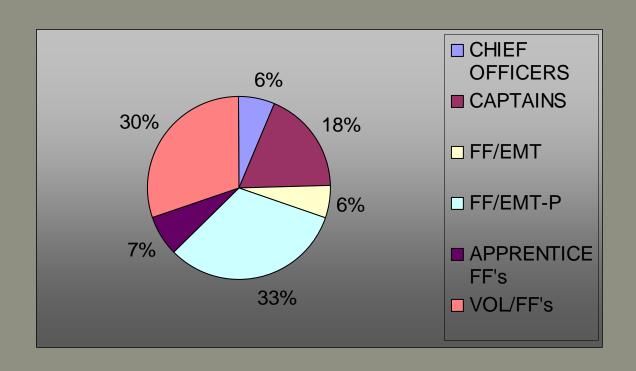
