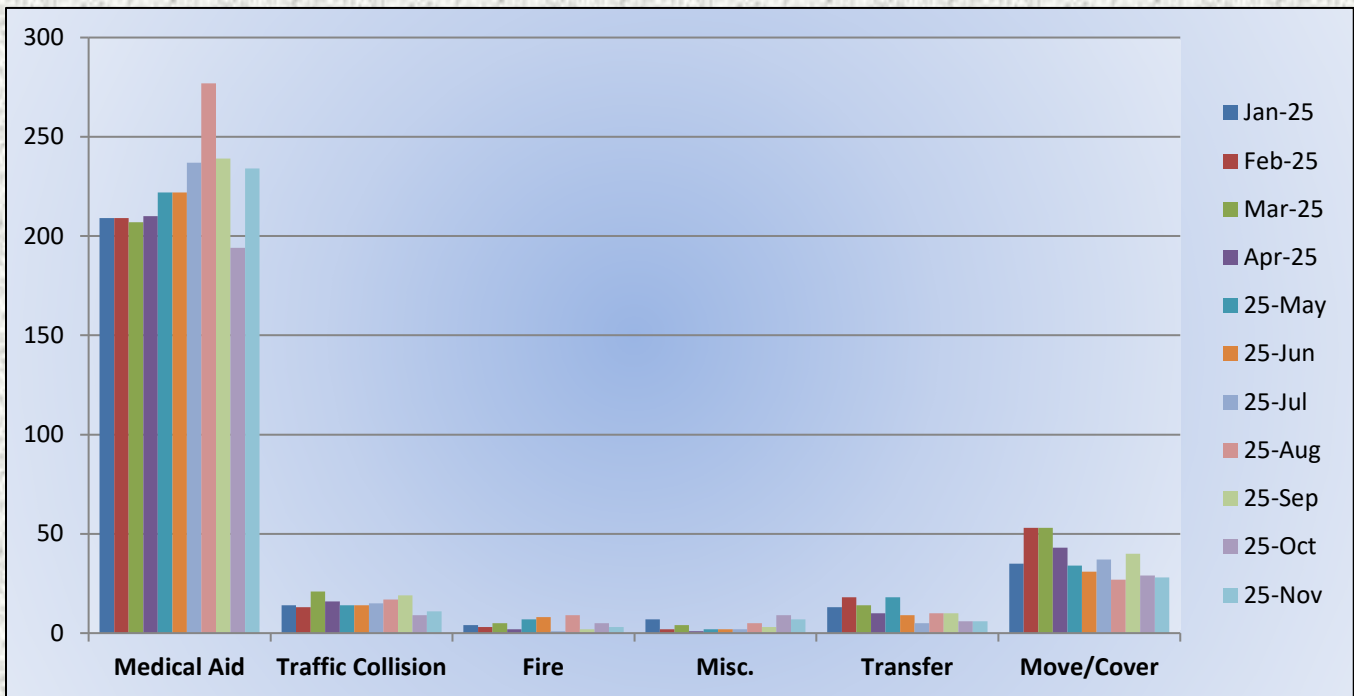
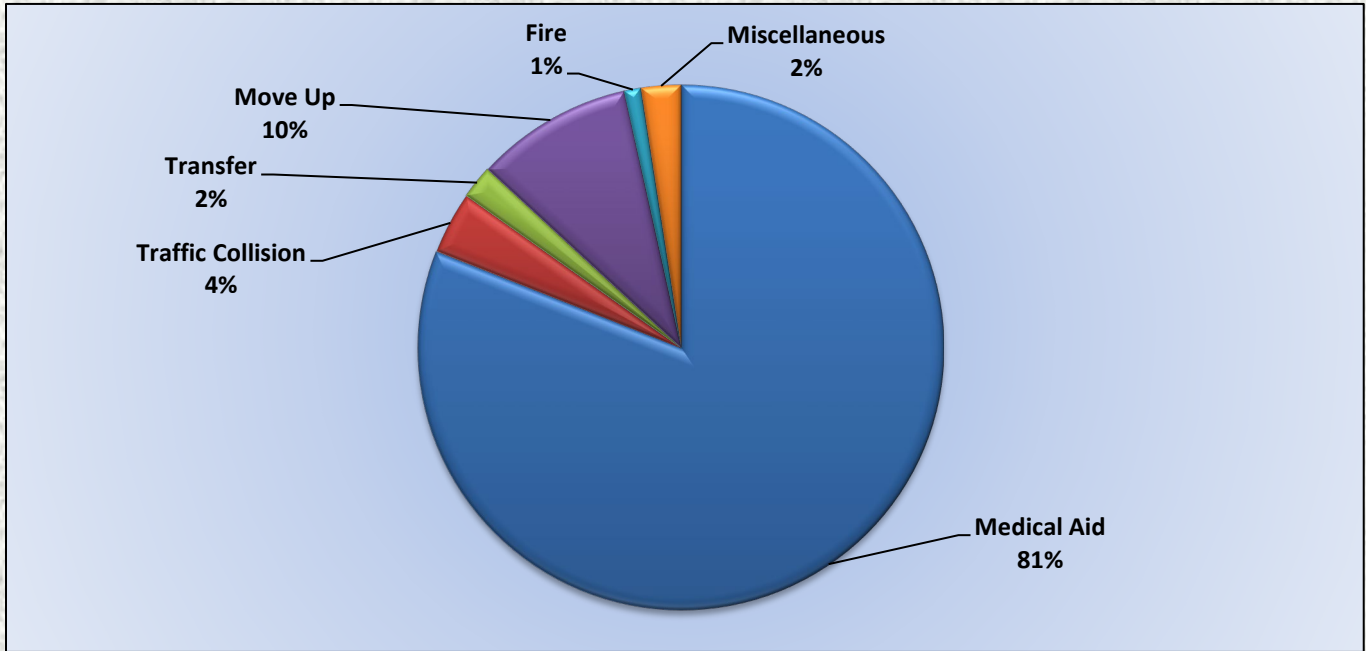
# Engine 25 Call Volume Breakdown
